4 X 5 Round Strings from Standing
(x1), Bench (x1), Sitting (x2)

The “Mad Minute” Rifle Match
20 Rounds Required

From the bench, 10 rounds in one
minute at silhouettes at 100 yards
Fired Twice (Keep “best of” score)

“At the Parapet” Rifle Match
20 Rounds Required

From a parapet & standing
(supported) at steel helmet
silhouettes, 5 rounds at 100 yards
and 5 rounds at 200 yards
Fired Twice (Keep “best of” score)

Great War Bullseye Pistol Match
40 Rounds Required

8 X 5 Round Strings @ 25 Yards on
NRA BC-8 Targets

Four Events, Maximum Score 600 Points Choose 3 of 4 Matches to Shoot for Record



A.) 100 Yard Military Rifle Match

20 rounds minimum

Course of Fire:

Bench Slow Fire - 5 rounds in 5 minutes
Sitting Slow Fire – 5 rounds in 5 minutes
Standing Slow Fire – 5 rounds in 5 minutes
Sitting Rapid Fire – 5 rounds in 30 seconds

Target Type:

NRA SR-1 (100 yard) Bullseye Target

B.) Great War Bullseye Pistol Match

40 rounds minimum

Course of Fire:

2x Slow Fire – 5 rounds in 3 minutes
2x Rapid Fire – 5 rounds in 20 seconds
2x Slow Fire – 5 rounds in 3 minutes
2x Rapid Fire – 5 rounds in 20 seconds

Target Type:

NRA B 8 (25 yard) Bullseye Target

C.) The “Mad Minute” Rifle Match

20 rounds

Course of Fire:

Bench Rapid Fire – 10 rounds in 1 minute
You will shoot this twice, keeping your best score
Mauser actions will shoot 5 rds in 30 seconds
twice (X2)

Target Type:

BT-5B (@100 yards) San Diego Training

D.) “At The Parapet” Rifle Match

8 - 50 rounds

Course of Fire:

Standing Supported on Sand Bags
3 minutes to engage all four targets, 2 at 100 yards
and 2 at 200 yards. Objective is to strike each target
once. You will shoot this twice, keeping your best
score (count + time to complete)

Target Type:

Helmeted Head Silhouette (steel gong)
Measuring approximately 9” X 13”
(target = Pickelhaube silhouette)
Scorers/Spotters will use 60X 100mm scopes to
record “hits”



In how many events can you shoot?

Contestants may participate in all 4 events. Only three will be counted towards scoring. Each event is worth a maximum of 200 points for a maximum match score of 600 points. (Shooters declare which 3 events will be used for record during registration). All shooters will participate in at least three events in order to be eligible for awards or prizes. Match Winner Trophy for best overall combined score, 1st Place in each event.

Registration?

Advance Registration is easy and helps us plan for the Lunch. Simply email PRESIDENT@MARIONROAD.COM and tell me your name, what matches you plan to shoot and what make and model of rifle or pistol you plan to use so that I may prepare score sheets.

Restrictions:

Armor piercing, tracer or incendiary ammunition is not allowed under any circumstances. An RSO (Range Safety Officer) may check your ammunition at any time. RSO decision is final.

Location:

The Marion Road Gun Club's Warchak Range is located at 6170 Marion Road, Macon, Georgia 31217 (take I-16 East to Exit 6, turn right onto Ocmulgee East Blvd for 1.3 miles then bear left onto Marion Road. The range entrance is located 1.6 miles on your left at the crest of the hill. Look for the blue signs.

Cost:

Registration fee for MRGC members is \$30

Registration fee for non members is \$30

The registration fee includes the cost of your lunch (\$5.00 for non-combatants)

Rifles and ammunition available for rental (\$90) that will allow you to compete.

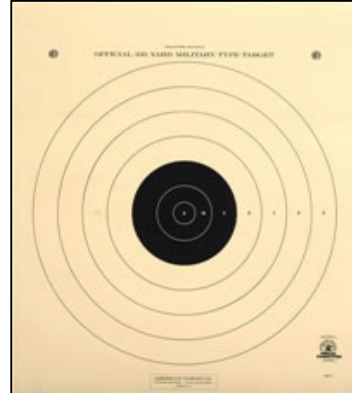

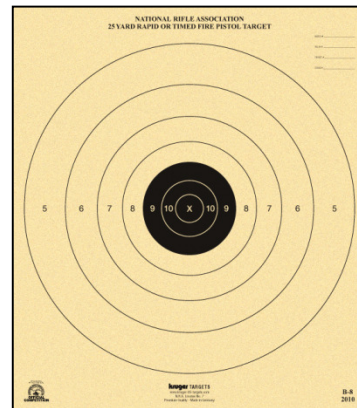
Match A

20 Rounds (+ spotters)



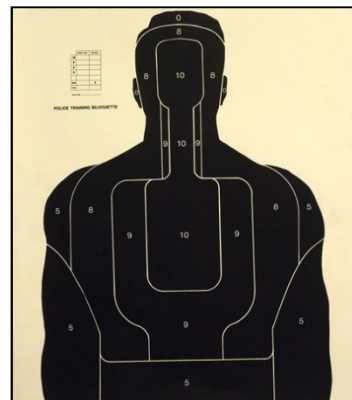
Match B
